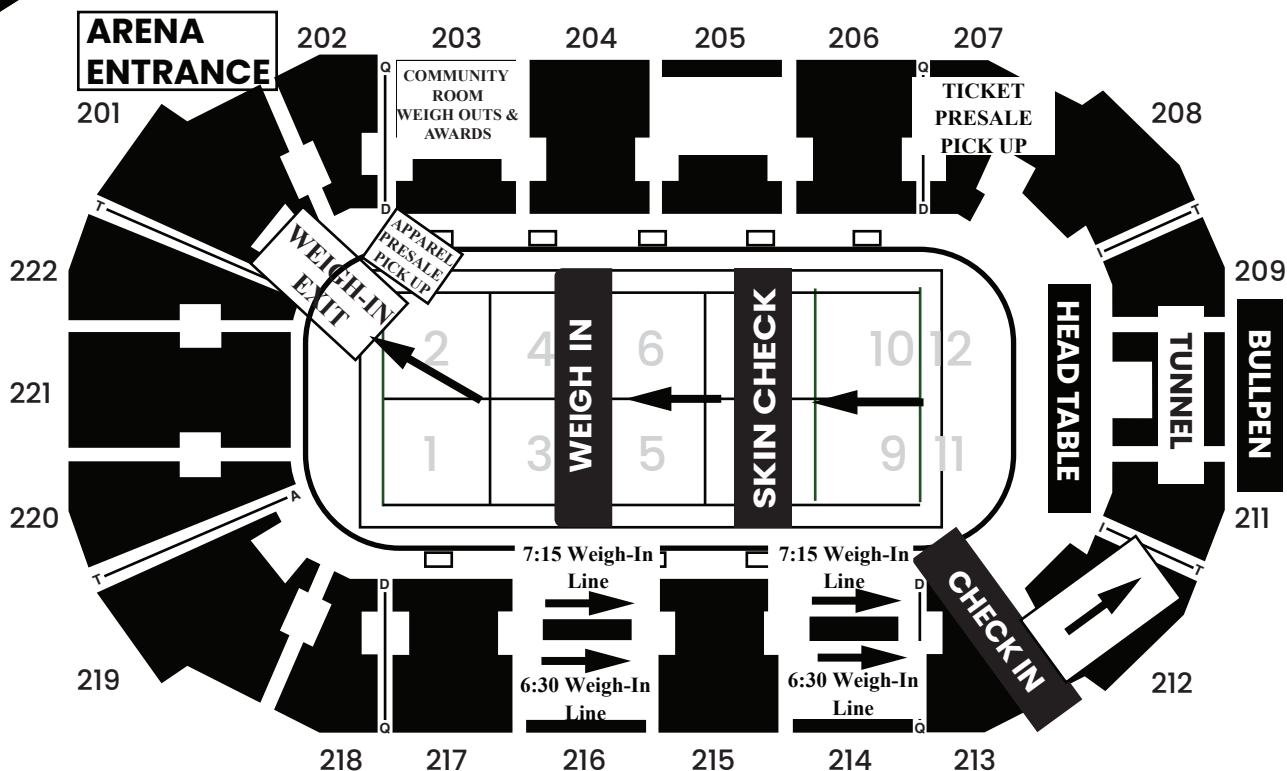

No food or drink permitted except small snacks for children. Medical necessities are permitted.

Wrestlers can bring a 12" x 16" cooler and one small competition bag. Bags will be checked.

For non-wrestlers/spectators - NO BAG POLICY - Only clear and see-through bags no larger than 12" x 12" x 6" and clutches no larger than 8.5" x 5.5" x 1" will be permitted. Exceptions may be made for medical bags and diaper bags.



- **No weapons including pocket knives**
- **No laser pointers, air horns or noise makers**
- **No large umbrellas (small collapsible ones are permitted)**

Limited day of on-site parking will be available for purchase on event day for \$10



OAC STATE FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Do I need to purchase a ticket for my wrestler?

Wrestler's competing at the State Tournament will receive their admission ticket at check-in during weigh-ins.

For the Junior High weekend. If a girl competes at OhWay or Junior High Boys tournament their weigh-in will be honored. If they are not competing at OhWay they will have to weigh in Saturday PM or Sunday AM weigh-in times (only get Sunday Ticket).

For GS weekend. If a girl competes in the boys tournament her weigh-in will be honored for the Girls tournament. If they are not competing in the boy's tournament they will have to weigh-in Saturday PM or Sunday AM weigh-in times.

Junior High Girls will receive a Saturday & Sunday Admission Ticket if weighing-in on Friday PM
Junior High Girls weighing on Saturday PM or Sunday AM will receive a Sunday Only Admission Ticket. Grade School Girls will receive a Sunday Only Admission Ticket at Weigh-ins.

Girls competing in the Boys tournament

Matches on either weekend will not be moved if they are competing in both tournaments. We will only skip up to 3 matches to allow wrestlers to get to another mat.

Where do I pick up presale tickets?

Presale Tickets, Coach Bands & Programs can be picked up Friday night under section 207 or Saturday or Sunday at Ticket Window. Please bring receipt.
Barbarian Apparel orders can be picked up at weigh-ins exit.

Can we purchase tickets at the tournament?

Tickets may be purchased online until Wednesday 9pm the week of the tournament or at the ticket box office. 5 and under are free.

Do all wrestlers compete both days?

Freshman State is Saturday only. Junior High & Grade School Girls State is Sunday only.

Grade School Division 1 is only Sunday.

Junior High Girls & Grade School Division 1 may weigh-in Friday night.

Junior High Boys & Grade School Boys (D2, D3 & D4) may compete Saturday & Sunday.

Is there a 2lb allowance? Are you accepting OHWAY girls weigh-in weights?

Junior High, Freshman, Girls & Grade School State receive a 2lb allowance., OHWAY Girls weigh-in weights will be honored for Junior High Girls.

Junior High Boys & Grade School Boys D3 & D4 will weigh-out Sunday 9am-10:30am. 3 lb Allowance from district weight.

Can the wrestler bring in food and drink in his bag?

Covelli Centre Food Policy: No Food or Drink allowed through admissions. Participants only are allowed a 12"x 16" cooler and one small competition bag. Bags will be checked. Absolutely no drawstring bags, backpacks, or other types of containers carried in by non-wrestlers.



COACHING BAND INFORMATION

Coaches must have a coaching band to access the floor and to sit in one of two coaching chairs.

With a Coach Band, you can...

- Coach your wrestler with one other coach from the designated coaching chairs
- Approach the table during a match for the following situations only ABC'S

A- Application of the rule

B- Bad Score/Bad Time-Error in match time or match score

C- Clarification of a rule

With a Coach Band, you CANNOT ...

- Approach the table to question a **judgment call**
(i.e., Takedown? Stalling? Near fall points? Claspings? etc..)
- Approach an official after that match

- Coach from the side of the mat or behind “the wall” if you are not a “corner coach.”
- Stay on the floor/designated coaching area after your match has concluded
- Step into the wrestling competition circle during the competition.
- Cross the arena floor by walking across the mat(s) lay-out (access it through the bullpen area)
- Access the floor through the bullpen WITHOUT your wrestler

Coaching from Chair Only

Coaching from the side of the mat(or behind the wall) by anyone who is not seated in the coaching chairs is **PROHIBITED**. Coaching from the side may result in a **MATCH POINT** being awarded to your wrestler’s opponent(unsportsmanlike conduct penalty). Coaches who continue with this offense may be charged with **Flagrant Unsportsmanlike Conduct** and may be ejected from the event.

Ohio Athletic Committee Sportsmanship Policy

- Show respect for self and others at all times.
- Respect the officials. Have the willingness to accept and abide by the decisions of the officials.
- Have a basic understanding and appreciate the rules of the contest.
- Recognize and appreciate the skill in the performance of all participants and tournament staff.

Any unsportsmanlike conduct by a wrestler/coach at an OAC event may result in a penalty up to and including a one-year ban from any OAC event. If the un-sportsman act is by a coach, parent, family member or anyone connected to a particular athlete the ban could also include the athlete. We will have a zero tolerance for unsportsmanlike behavior. The offending Coach is ineligible for all future Ohio Athletic Committee events until a letter requesting reinstatement along with a paid fee of \$100 to the scholarship fund is sent to the Ohio Athletic Committee. The Ohio Athletic Committee must approve the reinstatement. For a first offense, the period of ineligibility may be up to 1 full year. A second offense may result in a permanent ban from Ohio Athletic Committee events.
