

2023 Junior High, Freshmen, and Girls Wrestling State
Championships

START TIME: 8:00AM, DOOR TIME: 7:00AM (Saturday and Sunday)

No food or drink permitted except small snacks for children. Medical necessities are permitted.

Wrestlers can bring a 12"x16" cooler and one small competition bag. Bags will be checked.

For non-wrestlers/spectators - NO BAG POLICY Only clear and see-through bags no larger than 12" x 12" x 6"
and clutches no larger than 6.5" x 4.5" x 1" will be permitted.

Medical bags must be clear plastic bags.

Exceptions may be made for diaper bags.



- No weapons including pocket knives
- No laser pointers, air horns or noise makers
- No large umbrellas (small collapsible ones are permitted

Limited day of on-site parking will be available for purchase on event day for \$10 CASH ONLY



OAC STATE FREQUENLTY ASKED QUESTIONS

Do I need to purchase a ticket for my wrestler?

Wrestler's competing at the State Tournament will receive their admission tickets at check-in during weigh-ins.

Where do I pick up presale tickets?

Presale Tickets, Coach Bands & Programs can be picked up Friday night under section 207 or Saturday or Sunday at Ticket Window. Please bring receipt.

Barbarian Apparel orders can be picked up under section 213 on Friday night

Can we purchase tickets at the tournament?

Tickets may be purchased online until Thursday 9pm the week of the tournament or at the ticket box office. Wrestlers competing and children 5 and under are free.

Do all wrestlers compete both days?

Freshman State is Saturday only. Girls State is Sunday only.

Grade School Division 1 is only Sunday.

Girls & Grade School Division 1 may weigh-in Friday night.

Junior High & Grade School (D2, D3 & D4) may compete Saturday & Sunday.

Is there a 2lb allowance? Are you accepting OHWAY girls weigh-in weights?

Junior High, Freshman, Girls & Grade School State receive a 2lb allowance., OHWAY Girls weigh-in weights will be honored.

Junior High & Grade School D3 & D4 will weigh-out Sunday 9am-10:30am. 3 lb Allowance.

Can the wrestler bring in food and drink in his bag?

Covelli Centre Food Policy: No Food or Drink allowed through admissions. Participants only are allowed a 12"x 16" cooler and one small competition bag. Bags will be checked. Absolutely no drawstring bags, backpacks, or other types of containers carried in by non-wrestlers.

COACHING INFORMATION

With a Coach Band you can...

- Coach your wrestler with 1 other coach from designated coaching chairs
- Approach the table during a match for the following calls only
 - o Error in time
 - Error of Score
 - o Error of Starting Position
- Enter the floor through bullpen with your wrestler as he is escorted to the mat

With a Coach Band you CANNOT ...

- Coach from the side of the mat if; not one of the 2 coaches in the corner. It is a 1-point MATCH penalty.
- Stay on floor or designated coach area
- Approach the table during a match for the following
 - o To question a judgment call (ie: Takedown, Stall, Back points)
 - o Argue with an official after match
- Enter the floor through the bullpen without your wrestler


Coaches with Coach Band must...

- Stay in corner on coaching carpet
- Confirm the table has correct winner of match
- Leave the floor with wrestler when the match is completed

Ohio Athletic Committee Sportsmanship Policy

- Show respect for self and others at all times.
- Respect the officials. Have the willingness to accept and abide by their decisions
- Have a basic understanding, and appreciate the rules of the contest.
- Recognize and appreciate skill in performance of all participants and staff.

Any un-sportsmanlike conduct by a coach at an OAC event may result in a penalty up to and including a one-year ban from any OAC event. If the un-sportsman act is by a coach, parent, family member or anyone connected to a particular athlete the ban could also include the athlete. We will have a zero tolerance for un-sportsmanlike behavior. The offending Coach is ineligible for all future Ohio Athletic Committee events until a letter requesting reinstatement along with a paid fee of \$100 to the scholarship fund is sent to the Ohio Athletic Committee. The Ohio Athletic Committee must approve the reinstatement. For a first offense the period of ineligibility may be up to 1 full year. A second offense may result in a life-time ban from Ohio Athletic Committee events.



Junior High State Alternate Process

ALTERNATES WILL BE CONTACTED BY THE EMAIL ON WRESTLER'S ACCOUNT

When there is an opening in a particular weight class the selection process is as follows;

Alternates are placed up to 72 hours prior to State Weigh-In (Tuesday 6pm)

- 1. Spot goes to the wrestler who finished 7th at the District in which the vacancy occurs. If there is no 7th placer then;
- 2. There is a random draw of all other District 7th placers. If the spot remains;
- 3. The Spot goes the wrestler who finished 8th in the District in which the vacancy occurs. If the spot remains;
- 4. There is a random draw of all District 8th placers

If an opening occurs because a state qualifier has dropped out of the tournament, all remaining placers that were a lower placement than the wrestler that dropped out, move up a spot to cover the opening and the Alternate is give the spot of the 7th placer.

No wrestlers will be added after Wednesday the week of the State Tournament.
